GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Who is eligible to file a Claim? All Class Members may file a Claim. The court has defined the Class as: “all individuals residing in the United States whose PII was compromised in the Data Breach discovered by Peco Foods Inc. in December 2023, including all those individuals who received notice of the breach.”

Excluded from the Settlement Class are: (a) the Judge(s) assigned to the Action and their immediate family, and Court staff; (b) officers, directors, members and shareholders of Peco; (c) persons who timely and validly request exclusion from and/or opt-out of the Settlement Class and the successors and assigns of any such excluded persons; and (d) any person found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be guilty under criminal law of initiating, causing, aiding, or abetting the criminal activity or occurrence of the Data Breach or who pleads nolo contendere to any such charge.

COMPLETE THIS CLAIM FORM IF YOU ARE A CLASS MEMBER AND WISH TO RECEIVE ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING SETTLEMENT BENEFITS.

AVAILABLE BENEFITS

Peco Foods Inc. (“Peco”) will pay for four benefits. You are not limited to one benefit. You may file a Claim for each benefit that you qualify for.

BENEFITS

Credit Monitoring Services. All Class Members are eligible to receive three (3) years of Credit Monitoring Services, and include the following features:

- (1) real time monitoring of the credit file at three bureaus;
- (2) dark web scanning with immediate notification of potential unauthorized use;
- (3) comprehensive public record monitoring; and
- (4) access to fraud resolution agents to help investigate and resolve instances of identity theft.

Ordinary Out-of-Pocket Losses. If you incurred actual, documented out-of-pocket losses due to the Data Breach, you may file a Claim for reimbursement. The maximum amount of this reimbursement is \$1,000.00.

You must provide documentation and an attestation under penalty of perjury related to the Data Breach.

This benefit covers out-of-pocket expenses like:

- (1) costs associated with accessing or freezing/unfreezing credit reports with any credit-reporting agency;
- (2) other miscellaneous expenses incurred related to any Ordinary Out-of-Pocket Loss such as notary, fax, postage, copying, mileage, and long-distance telephone charges; and
- (3) credit monitoring or other mitigative costs.

Extraordinary Losses and Attested Time. If you incurred actual, documented out-of-pocket losses due to the Data Breach, you may file a Claim for reimbursement. The maximum amount of this reimbursement is \$5,000.00.

You must provide documentation and an attestation under penalty of perjury related to the Data Breach.

This benefit covers out-of-pocket expenses like:

- (1) the unreimbursed costs, losses, or expenditures incurred as a result of identity theft or identity fraud, falsified tax returns, or other possible misuse of the Settlement Class Member's PII.

You must submit documentation, such as receipts, to verify the costs you incurred. You may submit "self-prepared" documents to clarify or support other submitted documentation, but self-prepared documents by themselves are not sufficient to file a valid claim.

Settlement Class Members with valid, documented Extraordinary Losses may also submit a claim for up to 10 hours of time spent remediating issues related to the Data Breach at a rate of \$40.00 per hour by providing an attestation and a brief description of: (1) the actions taken in response to the Data Breach; and (2) the time associated with each action ("Attested Time"). Reimbursement for Attested Time is included in the total of up to \$5,000.00 per person for Extraordinary Losses.

Residual Cash Payment. In addition to, or in the alternative to, making Claims for Ordinary Out-of-Pocket Losses and/or Claims for Extraordinary Losses and Attested Time, Settlement Class Members may elect to receive a cash payment, estimated to be up to \$550.00 on a claims-made basis.
